**Eligibility for Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine Expanded to Ages 12 Years and Older;
UPDATED: Vaccination Schedule**

Effective immediately, and following [U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention \(CDC\) guidance](#), adolescents 12 years of age and older may receive the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine.

Minors who are 12 to 17 years of age may only receive the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine as the Moderna and Johnson & Johnson/Janssen (J & J/Janssen) vaccines are not recommended for individuals below the age of 18 years. Minors must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian and provide government-issued identification to validate age. The parent or legal guardian will also be required to sign a consent form on behalf of the minor to receive the vaccine. All residents 18 years of age or older are eligible for all three vaccine brands.
