Schoolwide Areas of Strength as Identified by the Visiting Committee

Domain 1: Mission and Catholic Identity

- The Mission statement of Dominican Catholic School is a clear visible summary that guides, highlights, and summarizes the call and purpose of the school. Rooted in the Dominican Charism of Catholic Tradition, the statement guides the school in its decision making by school leadership and is a guide for growth and evaluation by all shareholders.
- The Religious education program is an integral component of the curriculum of Dominican Catholic School, with the Catholic Identity clearly infused in all subject areas and manifested in the school's lived culture and faith, enhanced by a vibrant Catholic environment. At the heart of this identity, is the growth of all shareholders of Dominican Catholic School.
- Students at Dominican Catholic School encounter relevant and meaningful opportunities for various forms of prayer, the sacraments of Reconciliation and the Eucharist, with opportunities to grow in service within the school and wider community. Guided by the administrators, faculty, and staff, all members of the school community are given opportunities to grow in faith by the lived reality of action in service of Social Justice
- Masses, Retreats, and various spiritual experiences occur throughout the school year at the school that offer support for the spiritual needs of the faculty, staff, administrators and parents at Dominican Catholic School. These opportunities are interwoven with aspects of the call to Service of all shareholders, the parents, faculty, staff, and students.

Domain 2: Governance and Leadership

- The governing body and leadership team of Dominican Catholic School, under the care of the Dominican Sisters, collaborate with faculty, staff, students, parents, Chaplain, Catholic Schools Office, and Guam Department Of Education to develop and oversee the school's commitment to enhancing its mission, academic excellence, and operational vitality.
- The Province of Taiwan ensures the highest quality of leadership for Dominican Catholic School by providing leadership with academic qualifications and professional experience that align with the Dominican values, vision, and mission.

Domain 3: Academic Excellence

- Dominican Catholic School ensures curriculum alignment with the Archdiocesan Standards of Learning and Common Core State Standards, beginning with mathematics and progressively extending to other subjects for a cohesive academic framework.
- Curriculum, instruction, and assessment are integral to the school's academic framework, with a dedicated focus on meeting the diverse learning needs of all students.
- Teachers are committed to holistically developing students, thoughtfully integrating faith-based principles into the curriculum to nurture both academic and spiritual growth.
- The Volunteer Involved Parents (VIP) organization plays a vital role in supporting school activities, fundraising, and faith-based initiatives, while parents actively engage in liturgical celebrations and community service programs, fostering a strong school-community partnership.

- Domain 3: Fully integrate technology in learning and teaching in all grade levels
- Domain 4: Develop a comprehensive marketing plan.

Additional Critical Growth Areas Identified by the Visiting Committee

- As evidenced in interviews with faculty and the Leadership Team, there is a need to fully Integrate Technology in Learning and Teaching Across All Grade Levels in support of Academic Excellence and to equip faculty and students with the skills necessary to be successful in this technology driven world. Therefore, the Visiting Committee identifies the original Domain 3 goal to fully integrate Technology in Learning and Teaching Across All Grade Levels as an additional Critical Growth Area .
- In addition, the Visiting Committee highly recommends Dominican Catholic School to begin steps toward discussions, creation and implementation of a Leadership Succession plan in light of the decline of new religious entering the order and aging out of current religious.
